

PhD Position: Dairy Cattle Health and Reproduction

The College of Veterinary Medicine (Pullman, WA) at Washington State University is accepting applications for one PhD position. The 4-year program is expected to start in August 2024 or January 2025, under the mentorship of Dr. Caio Figueiredo. The selected candidate will conduct applied and basic research related to inflammatory/metabolic conditions in the transition period of dairy cows. The position offers scholar assistantship (approximately \$28,000/year for 4 years), tuition exemptions, and benefits.

- Experience in dairy cattle reproduction, health, or nutrition research
- D.V.M. degree or equivalent (preferred)
